

## Cartmel Peninsula Team Boundary Walk

The actual **Team Boundary** (a combination of the individual Parish boundaries), for a lot of its route is on (or in!) the estuary and alongside rivers.

This route, keeps as close to the boundary as is sensible / practical and picks up many of the high points and some low ones!

The total route is about 33 miles (53K) and is split into 5 sections with intermediate road crossings where people can start or finish if they are not walking the whole section.

- 1 Flookburgh to Haverthwaite 7 miles
- 2 Haverthwaite to Finsthwaite 7 / 9m
- 3 Gummars How to Meathop  
New Bridge 7m
- 4 Meathop New Bridge to Kents Bank 5m
- 5 Allithwaite to Flookburgh 7m

Each leg is obviously a one-way walk, so transport will need to be planned

## Suggested Plan for the whole event

This includes the idea that we have coffee / prayers in selected churches / halls at the same time, so that those that are not walking can be involved. 10.00 start proposed

March 16<sup>th</sup> Flookburgh to Haverthwaite 7 miles  
Good tracks / paths all the way mainly following the Cumbria Coastal path via the high ground of Howbarrow and Bigland Tarn.

Prayer / Coffee – Flookburgh and Haverthwaite

March 23<sup>rd</sup>

We join with Field Broughton Church on their annual walk around their Parish. (This looks quite long 10+ miles, so checking re: intermediate points etc.)

March 26<sup>th</sup> (Tuesday)

March 30<sup>th</sup>

Haverthwaite to Finsthwaite 7m or 9.5m

Fairly easy, following River Leven and Rusland Pool, then "inland" to Finsthwaite. (optional extra loop around High Dam)

Prayer / Coffee – Haverthwaite and Finsthwaite

April 6<sup>th</sup>

Gummars How CP to Meathop New Bridge 7m

Mainly working downhill following the boundaries of Staveley and Lindale.

Prayer / Coffee – Staveley and Grange

(optional up and down Gummars How for those who want to arrive an hour early!)

April 13<sup>th</sup>

Allithwaite to Flookburgh 7m

Easy flat route following the estuary as much as possible

Prayer / Coffee – Allithwaite and Flookburgh
